



In the event that evacuation is necessary you will likely be staying in an emergency evacuation centre, a hotel or with family or friends.

During this time, you will need items to ensure you and your family are comfortable.

BE PREPARED - Pack early and have your necessary items ready for a quick evacuation.

Supplies for a Disaster Evacuation Kit

- Keys to your home, vehicles, and other important keys
- Cash (electronic payment may be unavailable for a short time during some emergencies)
- Important documents stored in a water tight case to be kept with you. Include the deed to your home, insurance documents and wills
- ID: including drivers licenses, passports, birth certificates and SIN numbers should be with you
- One weeks worth of weather appropriate clothing and footwear. Pack lightly
- All medications, health supplies and equipment. Include prescription refills and necessary medical records
- Pack necessary toiletries used on daily and weekly basis
- Electronic devices with their power cords and a back up power source if you have one
- Prepare a kit for each pet. Include food, pet vaccination records (in case you need to find separate shelter for your pet during the evacuation), bowls, leashes and carriers

Please pack the items listed for each member of your household separately, this will allow you to split up easily if it becomes necessary.

You may also wish to include your valuables or any electronics that contain sensitive information if these cannot be safely stored in your home, away from potential moisture damage.

The following optional additions can make a stay at an emergency evacuation centre more pleasant:

- Flashlight and batteries
- A few special toys for children
- A pillow and blankets or sleeping bag
